



# Welcome to New Life in Christ First Sunday of Epiphany/ Baptism of our Lord Jesus Christ

Luke 3:15-17, 21-22 NIV

<sup>15</sup> The people were waiting expectantly and were all wondering in their hearts if John might possibly be the Messiah. <sup>16</sup> John answered them all, "I baptize you with water. But one who is more powerful than I will come, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie.
